
SDQ with more informants


SDQ on different groups of 15-year-olds

Mothers and Fathers





■ Difference in SDQ rating between mothers and fathers (mother-father)

Higher disagreement on internal than external score

Discrepancies are driven by:



- Parental psychopathology:
 - Mother's self reported symptoms
 - Mother's psyc. diagnoses
 - -> More harsh rating
- Parental conflicts:
 - More conflicts -> More harsh rating
- Parent-child relationship:
 - Mothers no difference
 - Fathers more lenient rating

-> Need both parents SDQ rating
